CRITERIA

Qualifications

- Applicants must be involved in the beef cattle industry with plans to continue their involvement through their educational and career plans.
- By June 1, 2022, applicants must have been awarded a 4-year degree and be enrolled in and/or pursuing a post-graduate degree (Master's, PhD, Law Degree, Etc.)
- Applicants must be able to show experience and involvement in cattle industry leadership activities.
- Individual applicants must be annual or lifetime members in good standing of the Oklahoma Cattlemen's Association (OCA) or their state cattlemen's association (This **DOES NOT** include Student, Junior, College, Cattlewomen, Family, Ranch, Spouse, Parent, Grandparent, or Breed Association Memberships).

All application must be emailed, submitted online or postmarked by June 1, 2022.

Application & Interview Process

- A completed application packet includes: Application, Essay, Two (2) Letters of Recommendation, Minimum of three (3) proposed white paper topics, Resume and College Transcripts. The packet must be emailed or postmarked by June 1, 2022.
- The selection committee will evaluate all applications and select a group of 3-5 finalists they wish to interview in order to determine the recipient.
- Interviews will be conducted on Saturday, July 23, 2022, during the 70th Annual Oklahoma Cattlemen's Association Convention & Trade Show.

Recipient's Commitment and Opportunities

- The recipient will be notified at the conclusion of the interviews and should plan to accept their scholarship in person at the Closing Session of the 70th Annual OCA Convention & Trade Show on Saturday, July 23, 2022.
- The recipient will be expected to provide a white paper on an issue of importance to the cattle industry within a year of being selected. The topic will be selected based upon the recipient's area of study, proposed topics from the applicant and input from the selection committee. The white paper may be published in the Oklahoma Cowman magazine, on the OCA website or in the OCA enewsletter.
- The recipient may also be afforded speaking or interview opportunities on the topic of the white paper after publication.
