[Oklahoma City, OK – June 11, 2025] – The Oklahoma Cattlemen's Association (OCA) is set to host the 41st Annual OCA Ranch Rodeo from August 15 to August 16 at the Lazy E Arena in Guthrie, Okla. The OCA Ranch Rodeo has twelve ranch team cowboys competing in five different events that reflect many aspects of daily ranch life.

“This marks the 41st year of the OCA Ranch Rodeo, and our mission remains the same; cowboys coming together to make a real difference for Oklahoma kids,” said Michael Kelsey, OCA Vice President. “Over the 40 plus years of our Ranch Rodeo, we have raised over \$700,000 for the CHF. The event is also known as 'Cowboys Helping Kids' due to the OCA Ranch Rodeo's long-standing relationship with CHF. The CHF funds medical research and treatments for children located in the state of Oklahoma. The donations raised for CHF in Oklahoma remain in Oklahoma.
