### **Ford Drummond Elected President of Oklahoma Cattlemen's Association**

"My father was President in 1985, so it's a family tradition and legacy of giving back to this industry and organization. I look forward to serving the cattlemen of Oklahoma."

As a third-generation rancher, Drummond also manages his family's historic ranch in Osage County; a cow-calf and stocker operation that has been in continuous operation since the early 1900s. After living and working in Washington, D.C., he and his wife Vanessa returned to the ranch more than 20 years ago to raise their three children, Virginia, Frederick and Margaret, on the same land settled by his great-grandfather before statehood. As OCA President, Drummond is committed to ensuring the OCA remains a strong voice for its members. His priorities include advocating for sound policy, protecting and promoting the beef industry, and creating opportunities for future generations of cattle producers.
