

SPEECH CONTEST

- Speeches must be over any subject that pertains to the beef and or cattle business.
- Divisions: Ages are based on **January 1, 2025**
 - o **Novice-** ages 9 years and younger
 - o **Junior-** 10- 13 years ols
 - o Intermediate- 14-16 years old
 - o **Senior-** 17-21 years old.
- Time limits: Novice and Junior division speeches should be 3-5 minutes in length. Intermediate and Senior division speeches should be 6-8 minutes in length.
- Previous winners are eligible to compete again.
- Participants should be pre-registered by Friday, May 30, 2025

SALESMANSHIP CONTEST

- Contestants should attempt to "sell" the offering to the judge panel.
- Divisions: Ages are based on **January 1, 2025**
 - o Novice- ages 9 and younger
 - o Junior- 10-13 years old
 - o Intermediate- 14-16 years old
 - o **Senior-** 17-21 years old

- Each contestant in the Salesmanship contest should provide a picture, registration paper, and any other supporting material (s) to the judge panel. Contestants may bring their animal in place of a picture to the contest area if they would like.
- Animals may be sold as individuals or groups; semen, embryos or donor flushes may also be sold.
- There will be no time limit, the judge is allowed to ask questions while the contestant us selling. The judge ma asks various questions pertaining to the cattle industry or how the animal will fit into their operation.
- Previous winners are eligible to compete again.
- Participants must be a current OJCA member.
- Participants should be pre-registered by Friday, May 30, 2025

JUDGING CONTEST

- Age divisions will include:
 - o **Novice-** ages 8 years and younger
 - o **Junior-** 9-13 years and younger
 - o **Senior-** 14-21 years old.
 - o Ages are of January 1, 2025
- Open to all breed associations, FFA chapters and 4-H clubs. Participants (excluding adults) must attend school on Oklahoma.
- The top five teams and top five individuals in each division will be recognized.
- Registration will open at 7:00 a.m. on Friday, June 6, 2025

QUIZ BOWL

- Open to all breed associations, FFA chapters and 4-H clubs.
- Participation will be limited to the first eight teams to register in each division.
 Registration will open at 10 a.m. on Thursday, June 5, 2025, and will close when eight teams are registered in each division. Registration is first come, first serve.
- This is a team contest. Teams will consist of 3-4 individuals in the same age division. Participants can only compete on one team.
- Divisions: Ages are as of January 1, 2025
 - o **Junior-** 13 years and younger

- o **Senior-** 14-21 years old.
- o Ages are of January 1, 2025

COW CAMP CONTEST

- This contest will test the general knowledge of participants. Stations will be set up to challenge groups in several areas such as: Nutrition, Meats, Livestock Handling, Feeding, Beef Quality Assurance, Reproduction, etc.
- Teams must be pre-registered at show before contest begins.
- Participation will be limited to the first 10 teams to register in each division. Registration will open at 10 a.m. on Thursday, June 5, 2025, and will close when 10 teams are registered in each division or by 12 PM on Friday, June 6, 2025. Registration is first come, first serve.
- This is a team contest. Teams will consist of 3-4 individuals in the same age division. Participants can only compete on one team.
- Divisions will be Junior- 13 years and younger; Senior- 14 years and older. Ages are as of January 1, 2025.
- Teams will begin the contests at a scheduled time. Once you start your first station, you must complete all stations in the contest. No one other than participants will be allowed in contest area.

BEDWELL BROTHERS MEMORIAL TEAM FITTING CONTEST

- Time limit of 30 minutes for contest. 10, 5, and 2-minute warnings will be called.
- Contestants will have 30 minutes prior to start of contest to get set up in fitting area.
- All team members must be an exhibitor in the OJCA Summer Preview Show
- The animal must be provided by the team, being an entry at the 2025 OJCA Preview Show. The animal must also be owned by one of the team members.
- No spectators allowed in fitting area during contest; they will be allowed to watch from a
 distance.
- Participants will not be allowed to leave fitting area once contest has begun.
- Participants must have all equipment in place and ready at start time.

- Teams will be assigned group numbers that will be posted on chutes, that group number must be worn into the arena as a back number.
- Only one blower per team is allowed.
- Generators are encouraged.
- Added hair *will not* be permitted.
- If power failure occurs for one team, all teams will be asked to turn off all equipment and stop fitting until power has been restored. This will not count against 30- minute time limit.
- OJCA officials reserve the right to ask participant to leave due to rule infraction or misconduct.
- Each team must consist of 3 members; at least one team member must be 13 years or younger. All team members must have a steer or heifer entered in the 2025 OJCA Preview Show.

SHOWMANSHIP

- Showmanship divisions will be broken into heats. Heats will be placed from top to bottom. Judges will determine how many exhibitors from each division will return for the division champion selection.
- Showmanship is a no fit show.
- To be eligible to show, participants must sign up in their respective age divisions by 2
 p.m. on Thursday June 5, and must be OJCA members.
- The \$15 entry fee is payable to the show office and is nonrefundable.
- The age divisions are based off age as of April 1, 2025
 - o Pee-Wee- ages 4-7 years old
 - o **Junior** 8-11 years old
 - o **Intermediate-** 12-14 years old
 - o **Senior-** 15-21 years old

HEIFER & STEER SHOW RULES

Exhibitors must be members of OJCA.

- All breeds of heifers will follow the guidelines adopted by their respective breed association for the 2025 Junior Nationals.
- Entry fees (\$40/head) must be paid by 8 a.m., Friday. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to accurately complete the online entry form.
- All steers will be weighed-in by show officials.
 - Prospect Steers: 875 lbs. and under.
 Progress Steers: 876 lbs. and above.
- Proof of registration must be provided (paper or digital) and in the exhibitor's name for heifers to show in a recognized breed- bills of sale will not be accepted.
- If papers are not present at the time of check-in, the animal will be placed into the commercial/ crossbred breed.
- Breed representatives will determine if tattoos will be checked.
- Cattle may not leave the grounds once they arrive and must be in place by 8:00 AM Friday, June 6th. Any exhibitor who chooses to remove their cattle from the fairgrounds after check-in will not be allowed to show.
- No adhesive permitted in the heifer show.
- No added hair permitted in the steer show.
- No health papers needed.
- All decisions are final.

OCA - OYE FUTURITY HEIFER & STEER SHOW RULES

- A special division will be held for heifers purchased from the OCA-OYE Futurity Sale in 2024 or 2025. Steers must be purchased in the 2025 Futurity Sale.
- The entry fee will be \$40 per head.
- Futurity cattle may also enter the regular OJCA Summer Preview show; a separate entry fee is required.

- Futurity shows will follow OJCA show fitting rules.
- Proof of purchase is required; bill of sale is acceptable.
- The heifers will show at 8 a.m. on Saturday, June 7, 2025.
- The steers will show at the conclusion of the prospect steer show on Saturday, June 7, 2025.
- Heifers must be born after June 1, 2023
- Registered Heifer classes will be broken by age.
- Commercial Heifer classes will be broken by weight.
- Steer classes will be broken by weight.
- Minimum of 3 head required to make a breed in the futurity divisions.
- Placings in this division are not eligible for OCCA points.
